Conference Objectives:

The conference aims to promote the development of studies on the languages, literature, history, culture, education, socio-economic conditions, international relations, and political systems of Western, Central, and Eastern European countries in Mongolia. The conference also seeks to disseminate the knowledge of university researchers and academic institutions, strengthen professional capacity, facilitate information exchange, and to explore opportunities for implementing future joint research projects and programs in order to align the field of European Studies with contemporary teaching and research trends in international relations, country studies, linguistics, translation studies, and foreign language education.

Scope of the Conference:

Participation is open to foreign and domestic universities and institutions of higher education; research and scholarly institutes; relevant governmental and non-governmental organizations; diplomatic missions accredited to Mongolia; international organizations; as well as professional associations.

Conference Sessions:

- ➤ International Relations and Country Studies
- ➤ Linguistics and Translation Studies
- ➤ Foreign Language Education

Official language of the conference: Mongolian, English

Scope of topics:

- ➤ International Relations and Country Studies: Cooperation between Mongolia and European countries; international relations; regional studies; history, society, politics, and culture of European countries; and intercultural communication.
- ➤ Linguistics and Translation Studies: Contemporary linguistic theories and methodologies; disciplinary and interdisciplinary research; theories, principles, methods, and types of translation; translation criticism; and literary studies.
- ➤ Foreign Language Education: Research presenting innovative theoretical and methodological approaches to foreign language acquisition and teaching.

Presentation requirements:

- ➤ Submissions must be academically rigorous, grounded in scientific methodology, and present original and innovative ideas that have not been previously published or presented.
- ➤ The title and abstract must be provided in both Mongolian and English.
- ➤ Structure: The paper must include 3–5 keywords; an abstract of no fewer than 150 words in Mongolian and English; an introduction; the main body; a conclusion; a list of references; and a list of figures and tables. Figures must be submitted in JPG or TIFF format, and tables must be prepared using Microsoft Excel.
- ➤ The paper must be prepared using Microsoft Word.
- ➤ Formatting requirements: Font: Times New Roman, font size: 11 pt, line spacing: single, paragraph indentation: 0.2 characters.
- ➤ Length: 5–10 pages (A4 size).
- ➤ The first page of the paper must include the title/topic/, the author's full name, academic degree and title, institutional affiliation, and contact information (telephone number and email address).
- ➤ A PowerPoint (PPT) presentation must be prepared.

The full text of the paper must be submitted no later than February 28, 2026.

All submissions will be reviewed, and authors will be notified of the results by March 1, 2026.
